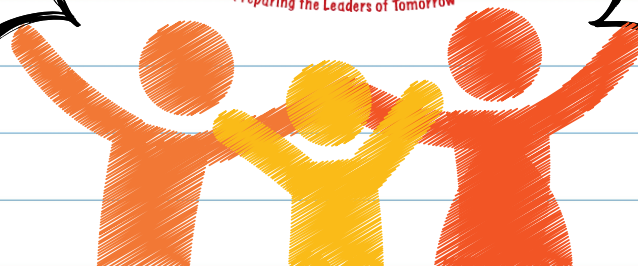
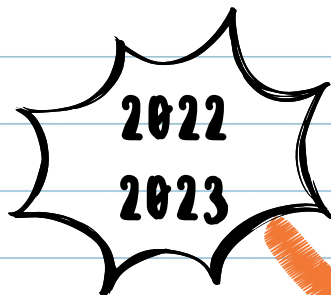

We have an Orientation meeting and an Open House during which you may become better acquainted with our staff and program. We believe that it is important that our staff be involved with families in close cooperation and planning of the welfare of each child. It is important that children experience a connection between home and the Early Childhood setting. In order to enhance this connection, we have created a Parent (Family) Committee. The Parent (Family) Board represents Paradise families while the Policy committee assists in decision making. Families may call with questions, suggestions, and ideas, or volunteer their time and energies to take part in the program. We hope that you will keep us informed by notifying us of any specific change that may affect your child at the center. In turn, we will inform you of any specific incident at the center concerning your child. The office will arrange conferences with families as needed. 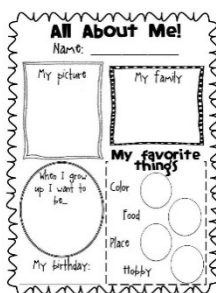
Welcome Back to School! Bienvenidos

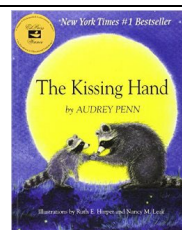

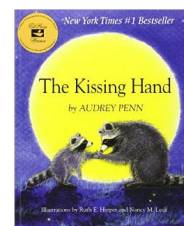

Transition-Parent Tip

➤ **Praise is key**, especially if your child is not in a cooperative phase. Try to catch her being good. Kids repeat behaviors that get attention.

➤ **No ifs.** Make requests

Transition-Parent Tip

Develop predictable routines. Kids cooperate in school because they know what's expected of them. "The children follow essentially the same routine day after day, so they quickly learn what they are supposed to be doing, and after a while barely need reminding." While it would be impractical to have the same level of structure at home, the more consistent you are, the more cooperative your child is likely to be. Decide on a few routines and stick to them: Everyone gets dressed before breakfast. When we come in from outside, we wash our hands. No bedtime stories until all kids are in jammies. Eventually, following these "house rules" will become second nature to your child.

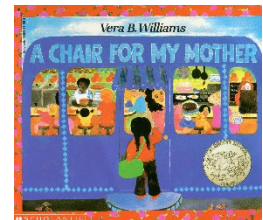

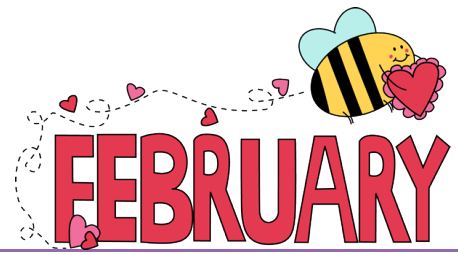

Transition-Parent Tip

Encourage teamwork. If your child is fighting over a toy with another child, set a timer for three to five minutes. Tell one child he can have the toy until he hears the buzzer, and then it will be the other child's turn.

No ifs. Make requests in language that assumes cooperation. "If you finish putting away your crayons, we can go to the park," suggests that perhaps your child won't clean up his crayons. Try instead: "When you put your crayons away, we'll go to the park."

Transition-Parent Tip

"Preparing for Kindergarten"

Prevent good-bye meltdowns. If your child is nervous about spending time apart, give him something tangible to remind him of you. Let him carry your picture; kiss a tissue or cut out a paper heart and put it in his pocket. Having something physical to touch may help him feel less anxious -- and short-circuit a tantrum.

Disciplining Effectively

Redirect. If your preschooler is jumping on the couch or grabbing for her big sister's dolls, distract her by asking if she'd like to draw a picture or read a short story together.

Involve her in righting her wrongs. If you find her coloring on the walls, have her help wash it off. If she knocks over a playmate's block tower, ask her to help rebuild it.

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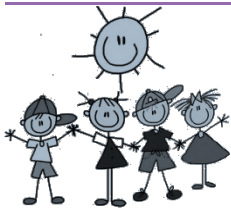

Going to kindergarten is an important life event. Preschoolers can feel excited—and a bit worried, too. Families have similar feelings, knowing their child is going to the “big school.” Preschool teachers want the children in their classrooms to be ready for kindergarten.

Talk to children about their feelings about the change. Share your own feelings, too. Children should have many opportunities to talk about their fears and concerns.

- Write and illustrate a book with your child about going to kindergarten.
- Visit the kindergarten class to make the transition smoother.
- Read books about going to kindergarten.
- Attend Kindergarten orientation and open houses
- Be involved in your child's school



Transition-Parent Tip

Assign a chore. Putting your preschooler in charge of a regular, simple task will build her confidence and sense of competency. A child who is entrusted to water the plants or empty the clothes dryer is likely to believe she can also get dressed herself or pour her own cereal. Just be sure the chore you assign is manageable and that its real work, not busywork, since even preschoolers know the difference. The goal is to make your child feel like a capable, contributing member of the family.
